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17	Section 1. Subsections (1) and (3) of section 320.025,
18	Florida Statutes, are amended, and subsection (4) is added to

22	(1) A confidential registration certificate and registration
23	license plate or decal shall be issued under a fictitious name
24	only for a motor vehicle or vessel owned or operated by a law

27	Unit <u>;, or</u> any state public defender's office; or any office of

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591-03237-21 2021762c1 30 forms furnished by the department, which includes a statement 31 that the license plate or decal will be used for certain 32 activities by the Attorney General's Medicaid Fraud Control Unit, or law enforcement, or any state public defender's office, 33 34 or any office of criminal conflict and civil regional counsel 35 which require the activities requiring concealment of publicly 36 leased or owned motor vehicles or vessels and a statement of the position classifications of the individuals who are authorized 37 to use the license plate or decal. The department may modify its 38 39 records to reflect the fictitious identity of the owner or 40 lessee until such time as the license plate or decal and registration certificate are surrendered to it. 41

42 (3) This section constitutes an exception to other statutes 43 relating to falsification of public records, false swearing, and 44 similar matters. All records relating to the registration application of the Attorney General's Medicaid Fraud Control 45 46 Unit, a law enforcement agency, or any state public defender's 47 office, or any office of criminal conflict and civil regional counsel, and records necessary to carry out the intended purpose 48 49 of this section, are exempt from the provisions of s. $119.07(1)_{\tau}$ and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution as long as the 50 51 information is retained by the department. This section does not prohibit other personations, fabrications, or creations of false 52 53 identifications by the Attorney General's Medicaid Fraud Control 54 Unit, or law enforcement or public defender's officers, or any office of criminal conflict and civil regional counsel in the 55 56 official performance of covert operations.

57(4) This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset58Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand repealed

The Legislature finds that it is a public 62 necessity that all records relating to the application of a 63 confidential registration certificate and registration license 64 plate or decal submitted by an office of criminal conflict and 65 civil regional counsel, and any other records necessary to carry out the intended purpose of s. 320.025, Florida Statutes, be 66 made exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s. 24(a), 67 Article I of the State Constitution. Investigations by an office 68 of criminal conflict and civil regional counsel may be 69 70 jeopardized by the registration of motor vehicles under the office's name or under the names of the office's investigators 71 72 in that persons under investigation may acquire such 73 registration information in order to seek retaliation against 74 the office or its investigators. Authorizing offices of criminal 75 conflict and civil regional counsel to obtain confidential 76 registration certificates and registration license plates or 77 decals in the same manner as any state public defender's office 78 would better ensure the safety of the regional counsel offices' 79 investigators in performing their official duties. 80 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.

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
