Each assessment shall be scored on a scale of 3 to 7. The 58 level of the credential each individual receives is based on the 59 following:

60 (a) A bronze-level credential requires a minimum score of
 61 3 or above on each of the assessments.

62 (b) A silver-level credential requires a minimum score of
 63 4 or above on each of the assessments.

64 (c) A gold-level credential requires a minimum score of 5
 65 or above on each of the assessments.
