28 WHEREAS, FGCU has strategically grown into a regional 29 university of nearly 15,000 students and today offers 63 30 undergraduate, 26 masters, and 7 doctoral programs, and

31 WHEREAS, FGCU has climbed 11 spots, to number 17, in the 32 Top Public School Regional University South rankings from U.S. 33 News & World Report, and has increased four-year graduation 34 rates by 13 percent from 2013 to 2015, and

35 WHEREAS, FGCU's pathways to student success have led to 36 achieving national prominence in academics, environmental 37 sustainability, and student service learning, with over 3 38 million hours contributed to the Southwest Florida community 39 since 1997, and
