- (a) A state university shall waive the tuition and fees, including lab fees, for one online course for a student who is a resident for tuition purposes under s. 1009.21 and is enrolled in an online baccalaureate degree program, provided the student meets one of the following eligibility requirements:
 - 1. Is a veteran as defined in s. 1.01(14);
- 2. Is an active duty member of the United States Armed Forces;
- 3. Is an active drilling member of the Florida National Guard; or
- $\underline{\text{4.}}$ Has not been enrolled in a postsecondary institution for more than 5 years.
- (b) For all other courses in the program, a state university may not charge a student described in paragraph (a) more than 75 percent of the tuition rate as specified in s. 1009.24(4) and 75 percent of the tuition differential pursuant to s. 1009.24(16), if the student remains enrolled in at least one online course during each academic year.
- (c) A student who qualifies for the tuition discount under paragraph (b) is eligible to receive the discount for up to 110 percent of the number of required credit hours of the degree program for which the student is enrolled.
