prior identification unless a no-knock search warrant has been
issued in compliance with this section. Such a warrant may not
be issued for investigation of a misdemeanor offense.
(3) A no-knock search warrant may be issued only if the
affidavit for such warrant:
(a) Complies with the requirements of this chapter.
(b) Specifically requests the issuance of a no-knock search
warrant.
(c)1. Has been reviewed and approved personally by the head
of the law enforcement agency requesting the warrant, who
