Remove lines 636-649 and insert:

requested to be mailed to an address other than the elector's
address on file in the Florida Voter Registration System, the
request must be made in writing. A written request must be ~~and~~
signed by the elector and include the elector's Florida driver
license number, the elector's Florida identification card

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14 number, or the last four digits of the elector's social security
15 number, provided, however, that if the elector affirms that he
16 or she does not have any of those numbers, the elector must
17 provide his or her name, address, and date of birth. However, an
18 absent uniformed service voter or an overseas voter seeking a
19 vote-by-mail ballot is not required to submit a signed, written
20 request for a vote-by-mail ballot that is being mailed to an
21 address other than the elector's address on file in the Florida
22 Voter Registration System. For purposes of this section, the
23 term "immediate family" has the same meaning as specified in
24 paragraph (4) (c).

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
