6 Remove lines 39-45 and insert:

7 (c) It is the intent of the Legislature to minimize the
8 negative effects of an extended significant emergency order
9 issued by a political subdivision. Notwithstanding any other
10 law, a significant emergency order issued by a political
11 subdivision must be narrowly tailored to serve a compelling
12 public health or safety purpose. Any such emergency measure must
13 be limited in duration, applicability, and scope in order to
14 reduce any infringement on individual liberty to the greatest
15 extent possible.

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16 (d) A significant emergency order automatically expires 7
17 days after issuance but may be extended, as necessary, in 7-day
18 increments for a total duration not to exceed 42 days.

19 (e) Upon the expiration of a significant emergency order,
20 a political subdivision may not issue a substantially similar
21 order.
