A bill to be entitled

An act relating to residential swimming pools; providing a short title; amending s. 468.8323, F.S.; requiring a home inspector to specify in his or her written report whether a swimming pool meets certain requirements; amending s. 515.29, F.S.; requiring that a pool barrier be used at certain times at a residence where a young child resides; amending s. 515.33, F.S.; requiring a property owner who owns a parcel with a swimming pool to provide a person purchasing the parcel with specified information relating to pool safety; requiring the purchaser to acknowledge the receipt of such information in writing; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. This act may be cited as the "Sylas Alexander Gatlyn Act".

Section 2. Paragraph (d) is added to subsection (1) of section 468.8323, Florida Statutes, to read:

468.8323 Home inspection report.—Upon completion of each home inspection for compensation, the home inspector shall provide a written report prepared for the client.

- (1) The home inspector shall report:
- (d) If there is a swimming pool, as defined in s. 515.25, whether the swimming pool meets at least one of the requirements under s. 515.27(1).
 - Section 3. Subsection (6) is added to section 515.29,

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Florida Statutes, to read:

- 515.29 Residential swimming pool barrier requirements.-
- (6) A swimming pool at a residence that has a young child residing at the residence must have a barrier in place any time the pool is not being used or cleaned.
- Section 4. Section 515.33, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
 - 515.33 Information required to be furnished to buyers.-
- (1) A licensed pool contractor, on entering into an agreement with a buyer to build a residential swimming pool, or a licensed home builder or developer, on entering into an agreement with a buyer to build a house that includes a residential swimming pool, must give the buyer a document containing the requirements of this chapter and a copy of the publication produced by the department under s. 515.31 that provides information on drowning prevention and the responsibilities of pool ownership.
- (2) A property owner who owns a parcel that includes a swimming pool, on entering into an agreement with a buyer for the purchase of such parcel, must give the buyer a document containing the requirements of this chapter and a copy of the publication produced by the department under s. 515.31 that provides information on drowning prevention and the responsibilities of pool ownership. The buyer must acknowledge, in writing, that he or she received such documents.
 - Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
