A bill to be entitled

An act relating to construction materials mining activities; amending s. 552.30, F.S.; specifying a ground vibration limit for construction materials mining activities in Miami-Dade County; authorizing the Chief Financial Officer to modify the standards, limits, and regulations for the use of explosives in connection with construction materials mining activities in Miami-Dade County; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (5) is added to section 552.30, Florida Statutes, to read:

552.30 Construction materials mining activities.-

- (5) (a) Beginning July 1, 2021, and notwithstanding any other law, rule, or ordinance, the ground vibration limit in Miami-Dade County for construction materials mining activities may not exceed 0.15 inches per second.
- (b) Notwithstanding this section or any other law, the Chief Financial Officer may modify the standards, limits, and regulations for the use of explosives in connection with construction materials mining activities in Miami-Dade County, including, but not limited to, the temporary cessation of blasting.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
