- (c) The estimated number and percentage of students who do not have Internet access or devices suitable for online learning, by district.
- (d) Details of state and local initiatives to provide students with Internet access or devices suitable for online learning.
- (e) Barriers identified by school districts to providing students with Internet access or devices suitable for online learning.
- (2) As part of its report, the department shall identify programming, initiatives, and strategies that were effective in providing Internet access and devices to students and supporting innovative instructional practices. The report must include recommendations, in consultation with the Office of Broadband, for appropriating remaining federal relief funding to close the digital divide for students without Internet access or devices suitable for online learning, consistent with best practices and according to geographical need.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
