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Representative Nixon offered the following:

Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove lines 35-39 and insert:

(3) (a) The Executive Office of the Governor shall develop a proposal for a state plan to assert state jurisdiction over occupational safety and health issues for government and private employees and shall designate or hire appropriate staff as necessary to develop the proposal.

(b)1. The proposal must include in the state plan the creation of a community advisory board to advise the agency that oversees the state plan. The advisory board shall consist of the

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13 following members, who must be approved by the head of the
14 agency that oversees the state plan:

15 a. A representative from the Department of Labor.

16 b. A representative from the Department of Economic
17 Opportunity.

18 c. A representative from the Department of Education.

19 d. A representative from the Florida Chamber of Commerce.

20 e. A representative from a small business as defined in s.
21 288.703, Florida Statutes.

22 f. Four representatives from labor organizations as
23 defined in s. 447.02(1), Florida Statutes, throughout the state.

24 2. Members of the advisory board shall be appointed for 2-
25 year terms, which shall be staggered.

26 3. Members of the advisory board shall serve without
27 compensation and are not entitled to receive reimbursement for
28 per diem or travel expenses.

29 4. The advisory board shall meet at least three times a
30 year in order to review reports and projects of the state plan.
31 Meetings of the advisory board must be open to the public and
32 provide the opportunity for public comment.

33 5. The advisory board shall submit an annual report to the
34 head of the agency that oversees the state plan. The purpose of
35 the report is to recommend changes to existing state policies
36 and programs to ensure worker safety and equity, with particular

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37 emphasis on low-wage workers, migrant workers, and racial
38 equity.

39 6. By January 1, 2023, and annually thereafter, the agency
40 that oversees the state plan shall submit the annual report to
41 the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of
42 the House of Representatives.
