Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove lines 57-86 and insert:

7 (3) Task force members shall serve without compensation
 8 but are entitled to reimbursement for reasonable and necessary
 9 per diem and travel expenses incurred in the performance of
 10 their duties as provided in s. 112.061, Florida Statutes.

11 (4) The Department of Transportation shall provide staff,
 12 assistance, and facilities as are deemed necessary for the task
 13 force to perform its duties. Funding for the task force shall be
 14 paid from the State Transportation Trust Fund.

15 (5) The committee shall meet at the time and location as
 16 the chair determines. The task force shall hold public hearings

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17 and receive public comment in locations throughout this state,
18 or by electronic means, such as teleconference, provided that a
19 means for active participation is accommodated.

20 (6) The task force shall:

21 (a) Assess and describe the current state of development
22 of the advanced air mobility industry, specifically, the
23 deployment of eVTOL aircraft. As used in this section, the term
24 "eVTOL aircraft" means a type of aircraft that uses electric
25 power to hover, take off, and land vertically without a runway.

26 (b) Identify federal, state, and local laws, rules,
27 regulations, and other requirements that may impact the
28 development of the advanced air mobility industry in this state,
29 including the potential deployment of eVTOL aircraft and
30 infrastructure.

31 (c) Recommend any changes to state laws and regulations
32 necessary to facilitate the continued development of the
33 advanced air mobility industry and deployment of eVTOL aircraft
34 and infrastructure in this state.

35 (d) Evaluate the potential integration of advanced air
36 mobility into local government transportation plans.

37 (7) By October 1, 2023, the task force shall submit to the
38 Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the
39 House of Representatives a report including the information,
40 findings, and recommendations required pursuant to subsection
41 (6) and any other relevant material deemed appropriate by the

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42 task force. Upon submission of the report, the task force is
43 abolished.
