3. A law enforcement agency shall disclose law enforcement geolocation information in the following instances:

a. Upon a request from a state or federal law enforcement agency;

b. When a person files a petition with the circuit court in

the jurisdiction where the agency having custody of the
requested law enforcement geolocation information is located
specifying the reasons for requesting such information and the
court, upon a showing of good cause, issues an order authorizing
the release of the law enforcement geolocation information. In
all cases in which the court releases law enforcement
geolocation information under this sub-subparagraph, such
information must be viewed or copied under the direct
supervision of the custodian of the record or his or her
designee; or

c. When law enforcement geolocation information is
requested for use in a criminal, civil, or administrative
proceeding. This sub-subparagraph does not prohibit a court in
such a criminal, civil, or administrative proceeding, upon a
showing of good cause, from restricting or otherwise controlling
the disclosure of such information.
