 - a. Upon a request from a state or federal law enforcement agency;
 - b. When a person files a petition with the circuit court in



the jurisdiction where the agency having custody of the 12 13 requested law enforcement geolocation information is located 14 specifying the reasons for requesting such information and the 15 court, upon a showing of good cause, issues an order authorizing 16 the release of the law enforcement geolocation information. In 17 all cases in which the court releases law enforcement 18 geolocation information under this sub-subparagraph, such 19 information must be viewed or copied under the direct 2.0 supervision of the custodian of the record or his or her 2.1 designee; or 22 c. When law enforcement geolocation information is 23 requested for use in a criminal, civil, or administrative 24 proceeding.
