 2 Representative Mooney offered the following:

Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove lines 47-108 and insert:

6 County on waters of this state within 10 linear nautical miles
 7 of a public mooring field or a designated anchoring area must
 8 pull anchor and be moved from its location using the vessel's
 9 propulsion system and be re-anchored in a new location. The new
 10 location must be:

11 1. No less than one-half linear nautical mile from the
 12 vessel's starting location. A vessel may not be re-anchored
 13 within one-half linear nautical mile from the vessel's starting
 14 location for at least 90 days; or

15 2. In a different designated anchoring area. A vessel may
 16 not be re-anchored in its originating designated anchoring area

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17 for at least 90 days after anchoring within a new designated
18 anchoring area. ~~The commission shall adopt rules to implement~~
19 ~~this subsection.~~

20 (b) The commission, in consultation with Monroe County and
21 the Florida Keys National Marine Sanctuary, shall establish by
22 rule designated anchoring areas throughout the county. The
23 designated anchoring areas must:

24 1. Specify a maximum vessel draft for each area;

25 2. Be created only in locations where the water depth is
26 sufficient to allow vessels whose drafts are less than the
27 area's specified maximum vessel draft to navigate into and out
28 of the areas without grounding or stranding;

29 3. Not be located over coral reefs or other sensitive fish
30 or wildlife habitat, to the maximum extent practicable, as
31 determined by the commission;

32 4. Not be located in an area subject to ongoing hazardous
33 water currents or tides or containing navigational hazards; and

34 5. Not be located within navigational channels, setbacks
35 established by the United States Army Corps of Engineers
36 associated with federal channels, areas where anchoring is
37 prohibited pursuant to s. 327.4109, or any other lawfully
38 established areas that prohibit anchoring.

39 (c) Paragraph (a) does ~~The anchoring limitations in this~~
40 ~~subsection do~~ not apply to vessels moored to approved and
41 permitted moorings ~~or mooring fields.~~

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42 (d)-(e) A vessel upon the waters of this state and within
43 Monroe County for which the owner or occupant has established
44 the vessel as a domicile in accordance with s. 222.17 is exempt
45 from paragraph (a) Notwithstanding the commission rules adopted
46 pursuant to this section, this section is not effective for
47 Monroe County until at least 100 the county approves, permits,
48 and opens new moorings are available for public use, including
49 at least 250 moorings within 1 mile of the Key West Bight City
50 Dock and at least 50 moorings within the Key West Garrison Bight
51 Moorings Field. Until such time, the commission shall designate
52 the area within 1 mile of the Key West Bight City Dock as a
53 priority for the investigation and removal of derelict vessels.

54 (e) All of the following vessels within Monroe County on
55 waters of this state which are equipped with a marine sanitation
56 device other than a marine composting toilet that processes and
57 manages human waste using technologies that comply with United
58 States Coast Guard requirements must maintain a record of the
59 date of each pumpout of the marine sanitation device and the
60 location of the pumpout station or waste reception facility for
61 1 year after the date of the pumpout, and the record must
62 indicate that the vessel was pumped out within the last 30 days:

63 1. A vessel that:

64 a. Has enclosed living spaces or rooms; and

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65 b. Is used by a person as a dwelling or living space
66 overnight at any time, notwithstanding whether or not the vessel
67 is also used for navigation.

68 2. A vessel moored in a public mooring field.

69 (f) This subsection may not be construed to prohibit
70 anchoring for less than 90 days in areas within Monroe County.
