 10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 12 Section 1. Paragraph (d) of subsection (2) of section
 13 318.18, Florida Statutes, is amended, and subsection (24) is
 14 added to that section, to read:

15 318.18 Amount of penalties.—The penalties required for a
 16 noncriminal disposition pursuant to s. 318.14 or a criminal
 17 offense listed in s. 318.17 are as follows:

18 (2) Thirty dollars for all nonmoving traffic violations
 19 and:

20 ~~(d) For all violations of s. 316.126(1) (b), unless~~
 21 ~~otherwise specified.~~

22 (24) For all violations of 316.126(1) (b), double the
 23 amount listed in paragraph (3) (b), not to exceed \$500.

24 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
