8 Annually, the principals of the Early Learning Programs  
 9 Estimating Conference established in s. 216.136 shall develop  
 10 official cost of care information based on actual school  
 11 readiness direct services program expenditures and information  
 12 provided pursuant to s. 1002.92(4). Conference principals shall  
 13 agree on the cost of child care by level and care type, the  
 14 eligible population data, and the methods of computation. The  
 15 Division of Early Learning shall provide the conference  
 16 principals with all requested and necessary data to develop such

17 information. The data may include a matrix by early learning  
18 coalition of any full-time equivalent changes made by the  
19 division as part of its administration of the school readiness  
20 program. The Early Learning Programs Estimating Conference  
21 shall provide the official cost of care information to the  
22 Legislature at least 90 days before the scheduled annual  
23 legislative session.
