 10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 12           Section 1. (1) The following rules, as filed for adoption  
 13 with the Department of State pursuant to the certification  
 14 packages dated October 1, 2019, and November 4, 2021, are  
 15 ratified for the sole and exclusive purpose of satisfying any  
 16 condition on their effectiveness imposed under s.

 25 codified in the Florida Statutes. After this act becomes law,

27 | Administrative Code, the Florida Administrative Register, or  
28 | both, as appropriate. This section does not alter rulemaking  
29 | authority delegated by prior law, does not constitute  
30 | legislative preemption of or exception to any law governing  
31 | adoption or enforcement of the rule cited, and is intended to  
32 | preserve the status of any cited rule as a rule under chapter  
33 | 120, Florida Statutes. This section does not cure any rulemaking  
34 | defect or preempt any challenge based on lack of authority or a  
35 | violation of the legal requirements governing the adoption of  
36 | any rule cited.

37 | Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
