Remove lines 16-29 and insert:

7 (23) The following conditions apply to all contracts,
8 except contracts for the collection or disposal of storm-
9 generated yard trash as defined in s. 403.703(42) between a
10 county or municipality for the collection or transport of solid
11 waste or recyclable material executed or renewed on or after
12 July 1, 2022:

13 (a) The governing body of any local government may not
14 seek liquidated damages or similar charges against a public or
15 private solid waste management or recycling entity which
16 provides residential municipal solid waste or recycling services

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17 when a local, state, or federal emergency is in effect and the
18 emergency materially affects the ability of the solid waste
19 management or recycling services entity to provide residential
20 municipal solid waste or recycling services.

21 (b) Any liquidated damages or similar charges by a
22 governmental entity for the failure to provide solid waste or
23 recycling collection services to a specific residential customer
24 for a specific day must be calculated and limited to not exceed
25 50 percent of the amount billed to that specific residential
26 customer for that day at the daily rate for collection services.
