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17 information contained in a motor vehicle record may be released  
18 ~~only~~ to:

19 a. Llaw enforcement agencies for purposes of contacting  
20 those listed in the event of an emergency.

21 b. A receiving facility, hospital or licensed  
22 detoxification or addictions receiving facility pursuant to ss.  
23 394.463(2) (a) and 397.6772(1) (a) for the sole purpose of  
24 informing a patient's emergency contacts of the patient's
