7 (28) DONOR HUMAN MILK BANK SERVICES.- The agency may pay
 8 for the provision of donor human milk and human milk products
 9 derived therefrom for inpatient use, for which a licensed
 10 physician, nurse practitioner, physician assistant or dietitian
 11 has issued an order for an infant who is medically or physically
 12 unable to receive maternal breast milk or breastfeed or whose
 13 mother is medically or physically unable to produce maternal
 14 breast milk or breastfeed. Such infant must have a documented
 15 birth weight of 1,800 grams or less; have a congenital or
 16 acquired condition and be at high risk for developing a feeding

17 intolerance, necrotizing enterocolitis, or an infection; or
18 otherwise have a medical indication for human milk diet. The
19 agency shall adopt rules to include, but not limited to,
20 eligible providers of donor human milk and donor human milk
21 derivates. The agency is authorized to seek federal approval
22 necessary to implement this subsection.
