Remove lines 54-68 and insert:

reporting and reimbursement requirements.-

7 (1) By January 1, 2023, each law enforcement agency
 8 operating a county detention facility must enter into a written
 9 agreement with the United States Immigration and Customs
 10 Enforcement to participate in the immigration program
 11 established under s. 287(g) of the Immigration and Nationality
 12 Act, 8 U.S.C. s. 1357. This subsection does not require a law
 13 enforcement agency to participate in a particular program model.

14 (2) Beginning no later than October 1, 2022, and until the
 15 law enforcement agency enters into the written agreement
 16 required under subsection (1), each law enforcement agency

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17 operating a county detention facility must notify the Department
18 of Law Enforcement quarterly of the status of such written
19 agreement and any reason for noncompliance with this section, if
20 applicable.

21 (3) A valid written agreement required under subsection
22 (1) must include a clause requiring full reimbursement of the
23 actual costs associated with complying with the agreement by the
24 United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement to the local
25 government in which the law enforcement agency is located.
