5            Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

6            Section 1. Section 662.1465, Florida Statutes, is created  
7 to read:

8            662.1465 Confidentiality of Inventories and Accountings.-  
9 In a trust proceeding involving a trust governed by this  
10 chapter, inventories of the trust's assets and any accountings,  
11 whether interim, final, amended, or supplementary, are  
12 confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I  
13 of the State Constitution. The court shall seal any such  
14 inventories and accountings and may not release the sealed  
15 documents or information contained therein to the public but

16 shall make them available to the following individuals or  
17 entities:

18 (a) The settlor, as defined in s. 736.0103.

19 (b) Any fiduciary for the trust, including a trustee as  
20 defined in s. 736.0103.

23 (d) Any attorney for the settlor, a fiduciary, or a  
24 beneficiary of the trust.

25 (e) Any interested person, as defined in s. 731.201.

28 Section 2. Section 736.1304, Florida Statutes, is created  
29 to read:

30 736.1304 Confidentiality of Inventories and Accountings.-

31 In a trust proceeding involving a trust governed by this  
32 chapter, inventories of the trust's assets and any accountings  
33 are confidential and exempt from s. 119.071(1) and s. 24(a),  
34 Art. I of the State Constitution. The court shall seal any such  
35 inventories and accountings and may not release the sealed  
36 documents or information contained therein to the public but  
37 shall make them available to the following individuals:

38 (a) The settlor, as defined in s. 736.0103.

39 (b) Any fiduciary for the trust, including a trustee as

48 Section 3. The Legislature finds that it is a public  
49 necessity that, in a trust proceeding involving a trust  
50 regulated under chapters 662 or 736, inventories of the trust's  
51 assets and any accountings be made confidential and exempt from  
52 s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. Public disclosure of  
53 such inventories and accountings, which relate to a trust's  
54 assets and may contain sensitive financial information, in these  
55 trust proceedings can result in specific harm to beneficiaries  
56 and other interested parties, as such persons or parties could  
57 be targeted for fraud, exploitation, or abuse. Therefore, the  
58 Legislature finds that the need to protect the inventories and  
59 accountings in a trust proceeding involving a trust regulated  
60 under chapters 662 or 736 is sufficiently compelling to override  
61 the state's public policy of open government and that the  
62 protection of such information cannot be accomplished without  
63 this exemption.

64 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
