Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 1001.39, Florida Statutes, is amended, and subsection (3) is added to that section to read:

1001.39 District school board members; reimbursements
~~travel expenses.~~

(1) ~~In addition to the salary provided in s. 1001.395,~~
Each member of a district school board shall be allowed, from the district school fund, reimbursement of travel expenses as authorized in s. 112.061, provided that any travel outside the district that exceeds \$500 requires prior approval by the district school board to confirm that such travel is for

17 official business of the school district and complies with rules
18 of the State Board of Education. Any request for travel outside
19 the state must include an itemized list detailing all
20 anticipated travel expenses, including, but not limited to, the
21 anticipated costs of all means of travel, lodging, and
22 subsistence. Immediately preceding a request, the public must
23 have an opportunity to speak on the specific travel agenda item.

24 (2) Each district school board may reimburse a district
25 school board member for travel expenses for travel from the
26 member's residence incurred in the performance of a public
27 purpose authorized by law to be performed by the district school
28 board, including, but not limited to, attendance at regular and
29 special board meetings. Mileage allowance in the amount provided
30 by law for reimbursement of travel expenses, when authorized,
31 shall be computed from the member's place of residence to the
32 place of the meeting or function and return.

33 (3) Each member of a district school board who does not
34 receive a salary shall be entitled to receive for his or her
35 services an amount not to exceed \$200 per regular and special
36 meeting held pursuant to s. 1001.372, not to exceed \$4,800 per
37 year per member.
