Section 1. Subsection (9) of section 119.07, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

119.07 Inspection and copying of records; photographing public records; fees; exemptions.-

- (9)(a) After receiving a request to inspect or copy a record, an agency may not respond to that request by filing an action for declaratory relief against the requester to determine whether the record is a public record as defined by s. 119.011, or the status of the record as confidential or exempt from the provisions of s. 119.07(1).
- (b) If, after receiving a request to inspect or copy a record, an agency or a public body is unable to make the record immediately available for inspection and copying, the agency or public body must, within 5 business days after the request:
  - 1. Make such record available;
  - 2. Deny the request; or
- 3. Provide a written statement of the time reasonably necessary to determine whether the request will be granted or denied and the reason for the delay.
