Remove lines 24-44 and insert:

7 harass or disturb that person in his or her dwelling. As used in
 8 this paragraph, the term "dwelling" means any building,
 9 structure, or portion thereof which is occupied as, or designed
 10 or intended for occupancy as, a residence by one or more
 11 families.

12 (2) A person who violates this section commits a
 13 misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s.
 14 775.082 or s. 775.083.

15 (3) Before a person may be arrested for a violation of
 16 this section, a law enforcement officer, as defined in s.

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17 943.10, or any local, state, federal, or military law
18 enforcement agency must go as near to the person as may be done
19 with safety and shall command any person picketing or protesting
20 before or about the dwelling of a person to immediately and
21 peaceably disperse. If any such person does not thereupon
22 immediately and peaceably disperse, he or she may be arrested
23 for a violation of this section.
