23 WHEREAS, this state would benefit greatly from the 24 ratification of a comprehensive free trade agreement, which, 25 since the United Kingdom is currently the largest foreign direct 26 employer in this state and is the second largest market for 27 tourism, would create employment opportunities for residents of 28 this state as a direct result of reducing and removing barriers 29 to trade and free markets, and
