A bill to be entitled

An act relating to fees; amending s. 943.0425, F.S.; requiring an animal abuser to pay a specified fee upon registration and annual renewal with the animal abuser registry; providing for the distribution of funds; providing a contingent effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (3) of section 943.0425, Florida Statutes, as created by SB _____, 2022 Regular Session, is amended to read:

943.0425 Animal abuser registration.-

14 (3)

(c) A registered abuser shall personally appear at the sheriff's office in the county in which he or she resides to renew his or her registration information annually on the anniversary date of his or her initial registration or, if his or her anniversary date falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, on the first business day following his or her anniversary date. At such time, the registered abuser's photograph and information shall be reviewed to verify accuracy. The abuser shall pay a fee of \$25 for initial registration and each annual renewal with the registry. The sheriff's office shall retain \$10 of each fee collected, and the remainder shall be forwarded monthly to the department to help pay the administrative and maintenance costs of maintaining the registry.
