7 Section 2. Beginning September 1, 2023, in order to
 8 implement the amendment made by this act to s. 320.055, Florida
 9 Statutes, the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles
 10 shall give customers the option to renew their registrations on
 11 their dates of birth in 2024 or 2025. Customers whose dates of
 12 birth occur in the months of January through June may choose to
 13 renew for 1 to 18 months. Customers whose dates of birth occur
 14 in the months of July through December may choose to renew for 7
 15 to 24 months.

16 Section 3. This act shall take effect September 1, 2023.
