A bill to be entitled
An act relating to fraudulent proof of vaccination;
creating s. 817.354, F.S.; prohibiting specified
actions involving fraudulent proof of vaccination;
providing criminal penalties; providing an effective
date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 817.354, Florida Statutes, is created to
read:

817.354 Fraudulent proof of vaccination.—A person who
counterfeits, forges, alters, clones, or possesses a
certificate, card, or other physical or electronic medium that
falsely indicates that the holder of the certificate, card, or
other physical or electronic medium has been vaccinated against
a specific disease, with the intent to defraud, commits a felony
of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s.
775.083, or s. 775.084.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2022.
