(a) The department shall develop a Pap Corps Champions for Cancer Research license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The plate must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "To Imagine and Help Create a World Without Cancer" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

(b) The annual use fees must be distributed to the Papanicolaou Corps for Cancer Research, Inc., a Florida nonprofit corporation, as follows:

The remaining funds must be distributed with the approval of and accountability to the board of directors of the Pap Corps and must be used to promote and support awareness of critical lifesaving cancer research by the Sylvester Comprehensive Cancer Center through education, outreach, and clinical research.
