2 An act relating to compensation of retired or former
3 members of the Commission on Offender Review; amending
4 s. 947.04, F.S.; increasing the rate of payment for
5 work performed by retired or former commissioners
6 assigned to temporary duty; providing an effective
7 date.
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9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
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11 Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 947.04, Florida
12 Statutes, is amended to read:

13 947.04 Organization of commission; officers; offices.—

14 (1) Before July 1 of each even-numbered year, the Governor
15 and Cabinet shall select a chair who shall serve for a period of
16 2 years and until a successor is selected and qualified. The
17 Governor and Cabinet shall, at the same time that a chair is
18 selected, select a vice chair to serve during the same 2-year
19 period as the chair, in the absence of the chair. The chair may
20 succeed himself or herself. The chair, as chief administrative
21 officer of the commission, has the authority and responsibility
22 to plan, direct, coordinate, and execute the powers, duties, and
23 responsibilities assigned to the commission, except those of
24 granting and revoking parole as provided for in this chapter.
25 Subject to approval by the Governor and the Cabinet, the chair

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26 | may assign consenting retired commissioners or former
27 | commissioners to temporary duty when there is a workload need.
28 | Any such commissioner shall be paid \$200 ~~\$100~~ for each day or
29 | portion of a day spent on the work of the commission and shall
30 | be reimbursed for travel expenses as provided in s. 112.061. The
31 | chair is authorized to provide or disseminate information
32 | relative to parole by means of documents, seminars, programs, or
33 | otherwise as he or she determines necessary. The chair shall
34 | establish, execute, and be held accountable for all
35 | administrative policy decisions. However, decisions to grant or
36 | revoke parole shall be made in accordance with ~~the provisions of~~
37 | ss. 947.172, 947.174, and 947.23. The commissioners shall be
38 | directly accountable to the chair in the execution of their
39 | duties as commissioners, and the chair has authority to
40 | recommend to the Governor suspension of a commissioner who fails
41 | to perform the duties provided for by statute.

42 | Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
