9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

11 Section 1. Subsection (47) of section 320.08058, Florida
 12 Statutes, is amended to read:

13 320.08058 Specialty license plates.—

14 (47) LIVE THE DREAM LICENSE PLATES.—

15 (a) The department shall develop a Live the Dream license
 16 plate as provided in this section. Live the Dream license plates
 17 must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The
 18 word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the
 19 words "Live the Dream" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

20 (b) The proceeds of the annual use fee shall be
 21 distributed to the Dream Foundation, Inc., to be used in the
 22 following manner:

23 1. Up to 10 ~~5~~ percent may be used to ~~administer, promote,~~
 24 and market the license plate and for costs directly associated
 25 with the administration of the foundation.

26 2. At least 40 ~~60~~ percent shall be distributed equally
 27 among the sickle cell organizations that are Florida members of
 28 the Sickle Cell Disease Association of America, Inc., for
 29 programs that provide research, care, and treatment for sickle
 30 cell disease.

31 3. At least 10 percent shall be used for programs and
 32 services provided directly by the Dream Foundation, Inc., which
 33 assist inmates released from the custody of a county jail in
 34 this state or Florida Department of Corrections facility in
 35 successfully reentering the community.

36 4. At least 15 percent shall be distributed as grants for
 37 programs and services throughout this state which assist inmates
 38 released from the custody of a county jail in this state or
 39 Florida Department of Corrections facility in successfully
 40 reentering the community.

41 ~~5.3.~~ At least 20 ~~30~~ percent shall be distributed as
 42 scholarships to graduating high school seniors in this state who
 43 have at least one parent or legal guardian who is incarcerated,
 44 for the purpose of attending a state university, a Florida
 45 College System institution, a career center operated by a school
 46 district under s. 1001.44, or a charter technical career center
 47 under s. 1002.34 ~~to Chapman Partnership, Inc., for programs that~~
 48 ~~provide relief from poverty, hunger, and homelessness.~~
 49 Scholarships shall be awarded through a competitive application
 50 process. Fiscal oversight of the scholarship program shall be

51 performed by a certified public accounting firm.

52 ~~6.4.~~ Up to 5 percent may be distributed by the department
53 on behalf of the Dream Foundation, Inc., to The Martin Luther
54 King, Jr. Center for Nonviolent Social Change, Inc., as a
55 royalty for the use of the image of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

56 Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2022.
