53	(2) If November 7 falls on a day that is not a school day,
54	"Victims of Communism Day" shall be observed in the public
55	schools in the state on the preceding school day or on such
56	school day as may be designated by local school authorities.
57	(3) Beginning in the 2023-2024 school year, high school
58	students enrolled in the United States Government class required
59	by s. 1003.4282 must receive at least 45 minutes of instruction
60	on "Victims of Communism Day" on topics such as Mao Zedong and
61	the Cultural Revolution, Joseph Stalin and the Soviet System,
62	Fidel Castro and the Cuban Revolution, Vladimir Lenin and the
63	Russian Revolution, Pol Pot and the Khmer Rouge, and Nicolás
64	Maduro and the Chavismo movement, and how victims suffered under
65	these regimes through suppression of speech, poverty,
