Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 1000.39, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1000.39 State council; Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children.-

(c) Two members appointed by the Commissioner of Education, 15 one of whom shall represent a military installation located 16 17 within this state and one of whom shall represent the executive 18 branch and possess experience in assisting military families in 19 obtaining educational services for their children. The term of 20 each member appointed under this paragraph shall be for 4 years, except that, in order to provide for staggered terms, the 21 22 Commissioner of Education shall initially appoint one member to 23 a term of 2 years and one member to a term of 3 years.

(d) One member appointed by, and who shall serve at the pleasure of, the President of the Senate and <u>one member</u> <u>appointed by, and who shall serve at the pleasure of,</u> the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

(e) The Compact Commissioner and the Military FamilyEducation Liaison designated by the Governor under s. 1000.38,who shall serve as nonvoting, ex officio members of the council.
