7 Section 3. Section 1006.185, Florida Statutes, is created

9 1006.185 Opening remarks at high school athletic
 10 contests.—Each approved athletic association whose membership
 11 includes public schools shall adopt bylaws, policies, or
 12 procedures that provide each school participating in a high
 13 school championship contest, or series of contests, under the
 14 direction and supervision of the association, the opportunity to
 15 make brief opening remarks, if requested by the school, using
 16 the public address system at the event. Such remarks may not be

17 | longer than 2 minutes per school. The athletic association may
18 | not control, monitor, or review the content of the opening
19 | remarks and may not control the school's choice of speaker.
20 | Before the opening remarks, an announcement must be made that
21 | the content of any opening remarks by a participating school are
22 | not endorsed by and do not reflect the views and opinions of the
23 | athletic association. The decision to allow opening remarks
24 | before regular season contests is at the discretion of each
25 | school.
