Senate Joint Resolution

A joint resolution proposing the repeal of Section 27 of Article I of the State Constitution relating to the definition of marriage.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

That the repeal of Section 27 of Article I of the State Constitution is agreed to and shall be submitted to the electors of this state for approval or rejection at the next general election or at an earlier special election specifically authorized by law for that purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following statement be placed on the ballot:

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

ARTICLE I, SECTION 27

REPEALING THE DEFINITION OF MARRIAGE.—Proposing an amendment to the State Constitution to remove a provision that is currently unenforced and is preempted by federal constitutional law and that defines marriage as the legal union of only one man and one woman as husband and wife and further restricts other legal unions from being treated as valid or recognized marriages, or the substantial equivalent thereof, in Florida.
