| 12 | 843.22 Traveling across county lines with intent to commit      |
| 13 | a burglary  |
| 14 | (2) If a person who commits a burglary travels any              |
| 15 | distance with the intent to commit the burglary in a county in  |
| 16 | this state other than the person's county of residence, the     |
| 17 | degree of the burglary shall be reclassified to the next higher |
| 18 | degree if the purpose of the person's travel is to thwart law   |
| 19 | enforcement attempts to track the items stolen in the burglary. |
| 20 | For purposes of sentencing under chapter 921 and determining    |
| 21 | incentive gain-time eligibility under chapter 944, a burglary   |
| 22 | that is reclassified under this section is ranked one level     |
| 23 | above the ranking specified in s. 921.0022 or s. 921.0023 for   |
| 24 | the burglary committed.   |
