31	(d) "Head of the business organization" means the executive
32	director, director, general partner, manager, or any other
33	person under whose authority the powers of the business
34	organization are exercised and under whose direction the
35	activities and affairs of the business organization are managed.
36	(2) Notwithstanding any other law, an apprentice may enter
37	into a contract with a business organization for up to 3 years.
38	The contract must be signed by the head of the business
39	organization and the apprentice. If the apprentice is younger
40	than 18 years of age, the parent or legal guardian of the
