7 Section 8. Section 465.41, Florida Statutes, is created to
 8 read:

9 465.41 Distribution of compounded human drug products.-

10 (1) It is the intent of the Legislature to enhance
 11 communication and maximize federal and state resources for
 12 oversight of compounded drugs produced by traditional pharmacies
 13 and to enact an information sharing agreement with the federal
 14 Food and Drug Administration as a tool to monitor such drug
 15 products.

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16 (2) On an annual basis, and within 90 days after the
17 beginning of the calendar year, all licensees who ship
18 compounded human drug products interstate shall report to the
19 National Association of Boards of Pharmacy Information-Sharing
20 Network the information required by the Memorandum of
21 Understanding Addressing Certain Distributions of Compounded
22 Human Drug Products between the department and the United States
23 Food and Drug Administration as provided by the federal Food and
24 Drug Administration. Licensees shall provide the information to
25 the department promptly upon request. The board may adopt rules
26 necessary to implement and administer this section.
