7 Section 4. Subsection (9) of section 383.216, Florida
 8 Statutes, is amended to read:

9 383.216 Community-based prenatal and infant health care.—

10 (9) Local prenatal and infant health care coalitions shall
 11 incorporate as not-for-profit corporations for the purpose of
 12 seeking and receiving grants from federal, state, and local
 13 government and other contributors. However, a coalition need not
 14 be designated as a tax-exempt organization under s. 501(c) (3) of
 15 the Internal Revenue Code. The administrative services
 16 organization representing all Healthy Start Coalitions under s.

30 (a) When any person dies in this state:

- 31 1. Of criminal violence.
- 32 2. By accident.
- 33 3. By suicide.
- 34 4. Suddenly, when in apparent good health.
- 35 5. Unattended by a practicing physician or other
36 recognized practitioner.
- 37 6. In any prison or penal institution.
- 38 7. In police custody.
- 39 8. In any suspicious or unusual circumstance.
- 40 9. By criminal abortion.
- 41 10. By poison.
