**Amendment (with title amendment)**

Between lines 166 and 167, insert:

Section 2. By 2035, 100 percent of the electricity produced by the public utilities in the state must be generated from 100 percent renewable energy as defined in s. 377.803, Florida Statutes. By 2045, each public utility must reduce its carbon emissions to 80 percent of the levels it emitted in 1990. The Public Service Commission shall conduct and release study by July 1, 2023, that examines the aggregate renewable energy growth in the state and the state's ability to meet these goals. The study must recommend policies to accelerate growth to make
