6 (7) IDENTIFICATION CARDS.-

7 (a) The department shall issue medical marijuana use
8 registry identification cards for qualified patients and
9 caregivers who are residents of this state, which must be
10 renewed every 2 years ~~annually~~. The identification cards must be
11 resistant to counterfeiting and tampering and must include, at a
12 minimum, the following:

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13 1. The name, address, and date of birth of the qualified
14 patient or caregiver.

15 2. A full-face, passport-type, color photograph of the
16 qualified patient or caregiver taken within the 90 days
17 immediately preceding registration or the Florida driver license
18 or Florida identification card photograph of the qualified
19 patient or caregiver obtained directly from the Department of
20 Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles.

21 3. Identification as a qualified patient or a caregiver.

22 4. The unique numeric identifier used for the qualified
23 patient in the medical marijuana use registry.

24 5. For a caregiver, the name and unique numeric identifier
25 of the caregiver and the qualified patient or patients that the
26 caregiver is assisting.

27 6. The expiration date of the identification card.

28 (d) Applications for identification cards must be
29 submitted on a form prescribed by the department. The department
30 may charge a reasonable fee associated with the issuance,
31 replacement, and renewal of identification cards; however, such
32 identification cards must be provided at no cost for veterans
33 and minors. The department shall allocate \$10 of the
34 identification card fee to the Division of Research at Florida
35 Agricultural and Mechanical University for the purpose of
36 educating minorities about marijuana for medical use and the
37 impact of the unlawful use of marijuana on minority communities.

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38 The department shall contract with a third-party vendor to issue
39 identification cards. The vendor selected by the department must
40 have experience performing similar functions for other state
41 agencies.
