5 (7) IDENTIFICATION CARDS.—

6 (a) The department shall issue medical marijuana use
7 registry identification cards for qualified patients and
8 caregivers who are residents of this state, which must be
9 renewed every 2 years ~~annually~~. The identification cards must be
10 resistant to counterfeiting and tampering and must include, at a
11 minimum, the following:

12 1. The name, address, and date of birth of the qualified
13 patient or caregiver.

14 2. A full-face, passport-type, color photograph of the
15 qualified patient or caregiver taken within the 90 days
16 immediately preceding registration or the Florida driver license
17 or Florida identification card photograph of the qualified
18 patient or caregiver obtained directly from the Department of
19 Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles.

20 3. Identification as a qualified patient or a caregiver.

21 4. The unique numeric identifier used for the qualified
22 patient in the medical marijuana use registry.

23 5. For a caregiver, the name and unique numeric identifier
24 of the caregiver and the qualified patient or patients that the
25 caregiver is assisting.

26 6. The expiration date of the identification card.

27 (d) Applications for identification cards must be
28 submitted on a form prescribed by the department. The department
29 may charge a reasonable fee associated with the issuance,
30 replacement, and renewal of identification cards; however, such
31 identification cards must be provided at no cost for veterans
32 and minors. The department shall allocate \$10 of the
33 identification card fee to the Division of Research at Florida
34 Agricultural and Mechanical University for the purpose of
35 educating minorities about marijuana for medical use and the
36 impact of the unlawful use of marijuana on minority communities.
37 The department shall contract with a third-party vendor to issue
