By October 1, 2022, the University of South Florida, in consultation with the Florida Alliance to End Human Trafficking, shall develop and submit a proposal to the Attorney General for the creation of a unified statewide data repository for anonymous human trafficking data. The proposal will house the data repository within the University of South Florida's
