**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

Delete lines 184 - 215

and insert:

Section 2. By October 1, 2022, the University of South Florida, in consultation with the Florida Alliance to End Human Trafficking, shall develop and submit a proposal to the Attorney General for the creation of a unified statewide data repository for anonymous human trafficking data. The proposal will house the data repository within the University of South Florida's

12 outline the need for a unified data repository to serve as a  
13 portal to collect and analyze anonymous statewide human  
14 trafficking data, to inform statewide efforts to combat human
