 8 students who have been accepted at an aviation maintenance
 9 school that is located in this state, certified by the Federal
 10 Aviation Administration, and licensed by the Commission for
 11 Independent Education, regardless of the number of clock hours
 12 required by the school's curriculum. Such student's eligibility
 13 for the renewal of an award shall be evaluated at the end of the
 14 completion of 900 clock hours, and, as a condition of renewal,
 15 the student shall meet the requirements under s. 1009.40(1)(b).
