record of 6 or more years as a subordinate to a registered  
surveyor and mapper in the active practice of surveying and  
mapping, 5 years of which shall be of a nature indicating that  
the applicant was in responsible charge of the accuracy and  
correctness of the surveying and mapping work performed. The  
applicant must have completed a minimum of 25 semester hours
