(b) "Conviction" means a determination of guilt that is the result of a plea or trial, regardless of whether adjudication is withheld.

- (c) "Doughnut" means a maneuver performed while operating a motor vehicle whereby the front or rear of the vehicle is rotated around the opposite set of wheels in a continuous motion which may cause a circular skid-mark pattern of rubber on the driving surface or the tires to heat up and emit smoke from friction, or both.
- (d) (b) "Drag race" means the operation of two or more motor vehicles from a point side by side at accelerating speeds in a competitive attempt to outdistance each other, or the operation of one or more motor vehicles over a common selected course, from the same point to the same point, for the purpose of comparing the relative speeds or power of acceleration of such motor vehicle or motor vehicles within a certain distance or time limit.
- (e) "Drifting" means a maneuver performed while operating a motor vehicle whereby the vehicle is steered so that it makes a controlled skid sideways through a turn with the front wheels pointed in a direction opposite to that of the turn.
- (f) (c) "Race" means the use of one or more motor vehicles in competition, arising from a challenge to demonstrate superiority of a motor vehicle or driver and the acceptance or competitive response to that challenge, either through a prior arrangement or in immediate response, in which the competitor attempts to outgain or outdistance another motor vehicle, to prevent another motor vehicle from passing, to arrive at a given destination ahead of another motor vehicle or motor vehicles, or to test the physical stamina or endurance of drivers over longdistance driving routes. A race may be prearranged or may occur through a competitive response to conduct on the part of one or



more drivers which, under the totality of the circumstances, can reasonably be interpreted as a challenge to race.

(g) (d) "Spectator" means any person who is knowingly present at and views a drag race or street takeover, when such presence is the result of an affirmative choice to attend or participate in the event race. For purposes of determining whether or not an individual is a spectator, finders of fact shall consider the relationship between the motor vehicle operator racer and the individual, evidence of gambling or betting on the outcome of the event race, and any other factor that
