Remove lines 48-121 and insert:

320.08069 Digital license plates.-

(1) DEFINITIONS.-As used in this section, the term:

(a) "Digital license plate" means an electronic display

that:

1. Is designed to display the information required in this
chapter to be included on a physical license plate;

2. Is designed to be placed on a motor vehicle registered
under this chapter in lieu of a physical license plate; and

15 3. Has been determined by the Department of Transportation
16 to have a display that is readable by current automated license
17 plate recognition hardware and software.

18 (b) "Digital license plate provider" means a person or an
19 entity engaged in the business of providing digital license
20 plate hardware and services to motor vehicle owners.

21 (2) APPLICABILITY.—Except as otherwise provided in this
22 section or a rule adopted under this section, a digital license
23 plate issued under this section is subject to the laws of this
24 state applicable to a physical license plate. However, digital
25 license plates issued under this section are exempt from s.
26 320.06(3) (a).

27 (3) DIGITAL LICENSE PLATE ISSUANCE.—

28 (a) By October 1, 2023, the department shall allow a motor
29 vehicle registered under this chapter to be equipped with a
30 digital license plate in lieu of a physical license plate issued
31 under s. 320.06 pursuant to a contract between the digital
32 license plate provider and the department entered into under
33 (b). However, the purchaser of a digital license plate must
34 first obtain a physical license plate from the department before
35 obtaining a digital license plate from a digital license plate
36 provider.

37 (b) The department may contract with digital license plate
38 providers for the issuance of digital license plates, including
39 any services related to the issuance of digital license plates.

40 The contract must include provisions governing the protection of
41 personal and motor vehicle registration data, including
42 geolocation data, obtained by a digital license plate provider
43 in the performance of its services.

44 (c) The department may authorize the display of the motor
45 vehicle's validation on each digital license plate in lieu of
46 the validation sticker. The validation must display the owner's
47 birth month, the license plate number, and the year of
48 expiration or appropriate renewal period if the owner is not a
49 natural person. The validation must be displayed in the upper
50 right corner of the digital license plate.

51 (d) The department may authorize the use of a digital
52 license plate for electronic toll collection, if such use has
53 been approved by the Department of Transportation or other
54 appropriate tolling authority, or to display a parking permit.

55 (e) The department may establish procedures for displaying
56 the following information on a digital license plate:

57 1. An emergency alert or other public safety alert issued
58 by a governmental entity, including an alert pursuant to s.
59 937.021.

60 2. Static logo displays, including unique displays for
61 fleet license plates as described in s. 320.0657 and digital
62 versions of specialty license plates as described in s.
63 320.08058, special license plates for military service as
64 authorized in s. 320.089, and special license plates for the

65 Governor and federal and state legislators as authorized in s.
66 320.0807.

67 3. Other displays that the department, in consultation
68 with law enforcement agencies, determines are in the interest of
69 public safety.

70 (4) DIGITAL LICENSE PLATE REQUIREMENTS.—A digital license
71 plate issued under this section must:

72 (a) Meet the specifications and requirements adopted under
73 subsection (3).

74 (b) Include the same information required to be included
75 on a physical license plate and legibly display that information
76 at all times and in all light conditions.

77 (c) Have wireless connectivity capability.

78 (5) DIGITAL LICENSE PLATE PROVIDERS.—A digital license
79 plate provider with whom the department contracts shall:

80 (a) Maintain an inventory of digital license plates issued
81 in this state by the digital license plate provider.

82 (b) Make available a digital version of each specialty
83 license plate authorized by the department, pursuant to
84 procedures adopted by the department under subparagraph (3)(e)
85 of this section.
